- Distinct code of conduct for the students, teaching and non-teaching staff.


B. Counseling

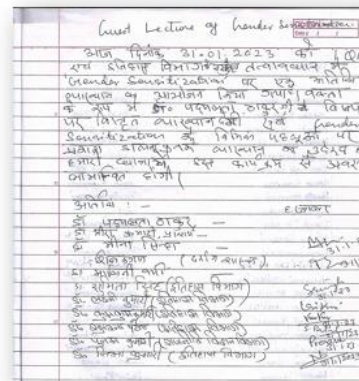
